

# Advent Bingo

## Need:

Poster board, milk caps to be markers.

## Directions:

Cut poster board into bingo card size and draw a bingo board consisting of at least 9 squares. In the squares put an answer from the Advent Bingo questions (make each card different). (Put clear contact paper on the cards and they will last for years).

Students play regular bingo, but they answer questions about Advent. The teacher asks one student at a time a question from the list below. The student answers the question and the class looks for the word on their bingo card. The first student who gets three in a row (up, down, across, or diagonal) on their bingo card first, wins.

## Advent Bingo Questions:

- What is the name for the special time of the year just before Christmas? **Advent**
- What does Advent mean? **Coming**
- The first Sunday of Advent begins a new Church \_\_\_\_\_. **Year**
- An Advent \_\_\_\_\_ counts down the days until Christmas. **Calendar**
- How many weeks does Advent last? **4**
- What is the primary Sanctuary colour of Advent? **Violet**
- How many candles are on the outside of the Advent wreath? **4**
- Each candle represents how many weeks? **1**
- Three candles are what colour? **Violet**
- What colour of candle is lighted first? **Violet**
- What does the first candle symbolize? **Hope**
- What colour of candle is lighted second? **Violet**
- What does the second candle symbolize? **Peace**
- What colour of candle is lighted third? **Rose**
- What does the third candle symbolize? **Joy**
- What colour of candle is lighted fourth? **Violet**
- What does the fourth candle symbolizes? **Love**
- What candle is lighted Christmas Eve or Christmas day? **White**
- The white candle symbolizes the arrival of Christ, the \_\_\_\_\_ of the world. **Light**
- What day do we celebrate the birthday of Jesus? **Christmas**
