


In Loving Memory of Permanent Deacon Dominic



The Veiled Virgin

The Veiled Virgin is a Carrara marble statue carved in Rome by Italian sculptor Giovanni Strazza (1818–1875), depicting the bust of a veiled Virgin Mary. The exact date of the statue's completion is unknown, but it was probably in the early 1850s. The veil gives the appearance of being translucent but in fact is carved of marble.

The statue was transported to Newfoundland in 1856, as recorded on December 4 in the diary of Bishop John Thomas Mullock. "Received safely from Rome, a beautiful statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary in marble, by Strazza. The face is veiled, and the figure and features are all seen. It is a perfect gem of art". It was then kept at the Bishop's Palace next to the Catholic Cathedral in St. John's, Newfoundland until 1862, when Bishop Mullock presented it to Mother Mary Magdalene O'Shaughnessy, the Superior of the Presentation Convent, because his blood sister, Mary de Pazzi Mullock was a vowed member of the Sisters of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The bust has since remained under the care of the Presentation Sisters in Cathedral Square, St. John's, NL. 



Holy Rosary Cathedral Vancouver

The parish began in June of 1885 when the Right Reverend Louis d'Herbomez, OMI, Vicar Apostolic of British Columbia, appointed Father Patrick Fay to care for the two settlements of Granville: Gastown and Hastings. Father Fay was chaplain to the Canadian Pacific Railway workers.

Father Fay said the first Mass on the Feast of the Holy Rosary, 1885. Regular Masses were held in Blair's Hall on Abbot Street and in Keefer's Hall, at Alexander and Water Streets. In 1886 there were 69 Catholic families in the "parish" and the need of a permanent church was obvious. The people decided to build. In choosing a site for the new church Father Fay looked south from the waterfront, up the slopes of the uncut forest, and pointed to the tallest tree, the land was acquired and a wooden church was built.

Records indicate that the first Mass was said in it on Rosary Sunday, 1889. The church was later enlarged and a bell tower built. (https://www.holyrosarycathedral.org/history/)

Mount Carmel Pilgrimage

One of the most significant events for the people living in Humboldt and surrounding areas is the Mount Carmel Pilgrimage. It takes place on a hill six kilometres north of Carmel, Saskatchewan. It was originally named spathanaw watchi in Cree, which means "the mount of the far view". The hill was once part of a homestead, but the farmer relinquished its title in 1921, donating it for the erection of a shrine to Our Lady of Mount Carmel. The Benedictines of St. Peter's Abbey, Muenster, Saskatchewan, established and dedicated it. Since the first pilgrimage held on September 10, 1922, which registered 3,500 people, countless pilgrims have climbed the hill to seek the intercession of Our Lady and pray for a bumper harvest under the Prairie skies.

The pilgrimage is held annually on the Sunday after the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, July 16. The annual pilgrimage includes prayers, the Rosary, Marian hymns, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Sunday Mass (traditionally celebrated by the Bishop of Saskatoon with priests, ministering in surrounding towns, concelebrating), the blessing of the sick, Stations of the Cross, and the blessing of the fields from the hilltop next to the statue of Our Lady and the Child Jesus. This pilgrimage has always been integral to the spiritual life of the people in the area once referred to as St. Peter's Colony.

St Peter-In-Chains Cathedral

The dream of building St. Peter-In-Chains began in August of 1825/1826, nearly 200 years ago, when Peter Robinson brought a group of poor Catholic immigrants from Ireland to the promised land of Canada. Forcing their way through seemingly impenetrable virgin forests, the people claimed their 100 acres of free land in "Peterborough" to realize the dream of a new life.

Even with many still living in tents, the newcomers begged the Bishop of Upper Canada for a priest, realizing their Catholic faith was necessary if they were to survive in the wilderness. Ten years after their arrival, the men, women, and children began, stone by stone, to build St. Peter-In-Chains Church, with the first Stone Church completed in 1838.


