There are many interesting things about Kenya that make it such a fascinating country.





NATIONAL FLAG




TAKE A SAFARI

ATHLETICS

Kenya has had a long history of distance running champions. This has continued even today. In June of 2023, Faith Kipyegon won 1500m in a world record time of 3.58.57 in Florence Italy. In Budapest in August at the World Championships, she broke the world record in the 5000 m in 14 min 5.20 sec. Long-distance runner Eliud Kipchoge claimed his second straight Olympic gold medal in the men's marathon at the Tokyo Olympics in 2020.

LENT 2024

As mentioned previously, Lent begins on Ash Wednesday February 14, with Easter Sunday following on March 31. Here are some thoughts that you probably already know:

- Lent is a time of *preparation* for the celebration of Easter.
- Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and lasts until Holy Thursday.
- Lent is a time of *prayer*, *fasting*, and *almsgiving* (which means sharing what we have with the poor).
- When you hear the word Lent, many Catholics think of *penance*, *purple*, *fish*, *ashes*, *fasting*, *sacrifice*, *giving up things*.
- Lent brings forth an image of *new life*—of *Baptism*.
- The last week of Lent is *Holy Week*.

Do you know what each of those thoughts means? With the help of your teacher, catechist, fellow students and parents, talk about each of them and get some understanding of them. Then you will really be ready for Lent!!

HCA PROJECT IN KITUI DIOCESE, KENYA



The HCA is presently contributing to the St John Eudes Rehabilitation Centre, founded in 2001. The school is located in the city of Kitui, which is approximately 150 km east of the capital city of Kenya, Nairobi. It is operated by the Catholic Diocese of Kitui. The student population consists of children who due to challenging economic and social conditions have been forced to live on the streets. The Centre aims to provide for their education and to promote lifestyle growth and provide emotional, psychological and material support. The aim is to integrate these students back into their families and communities.

Presently, the Centre is able to accommodate 46 boys and girls. By 2001, 700 children had been rehabilitated back into their homes and communities.
